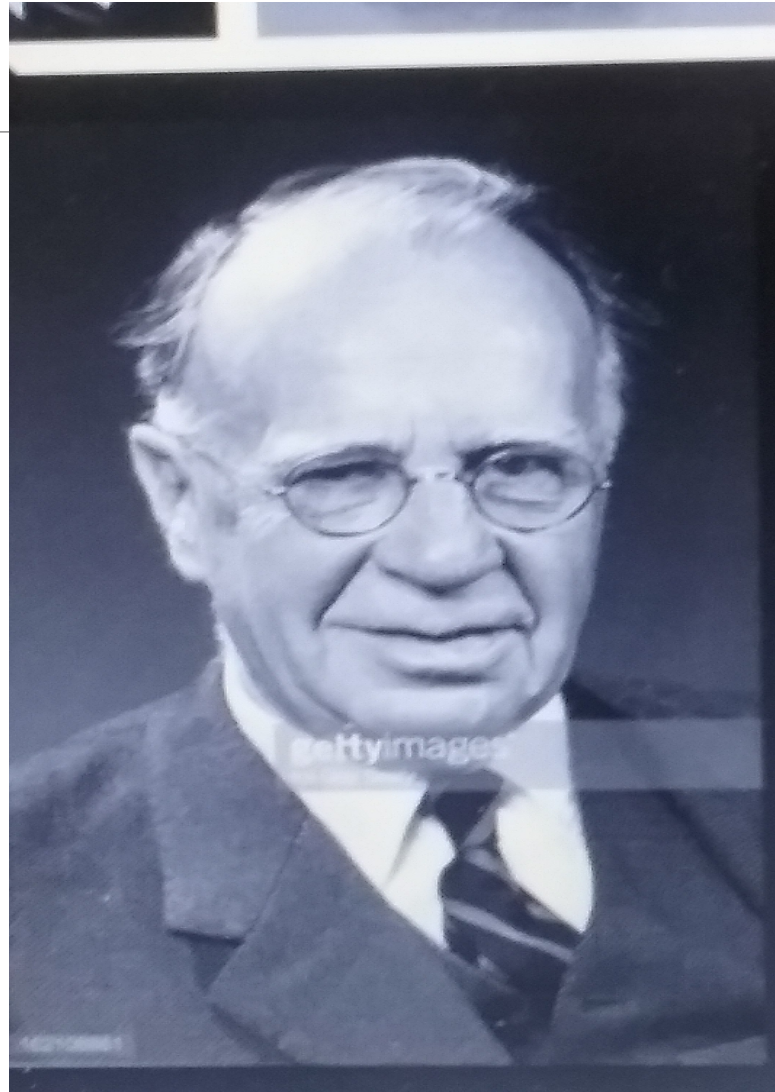

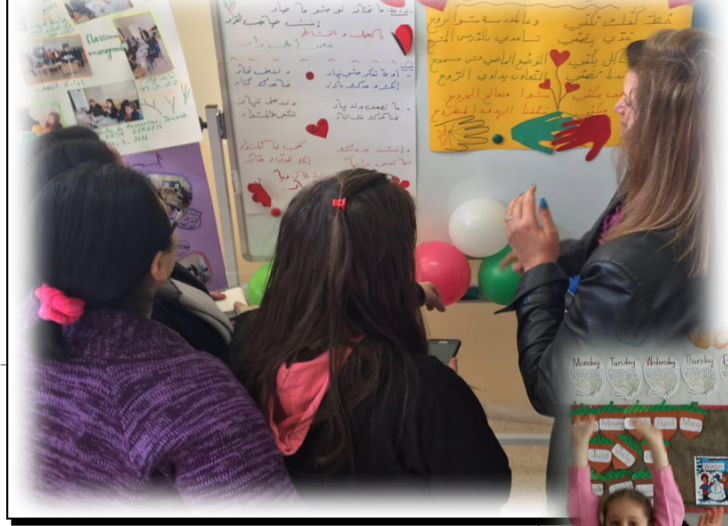

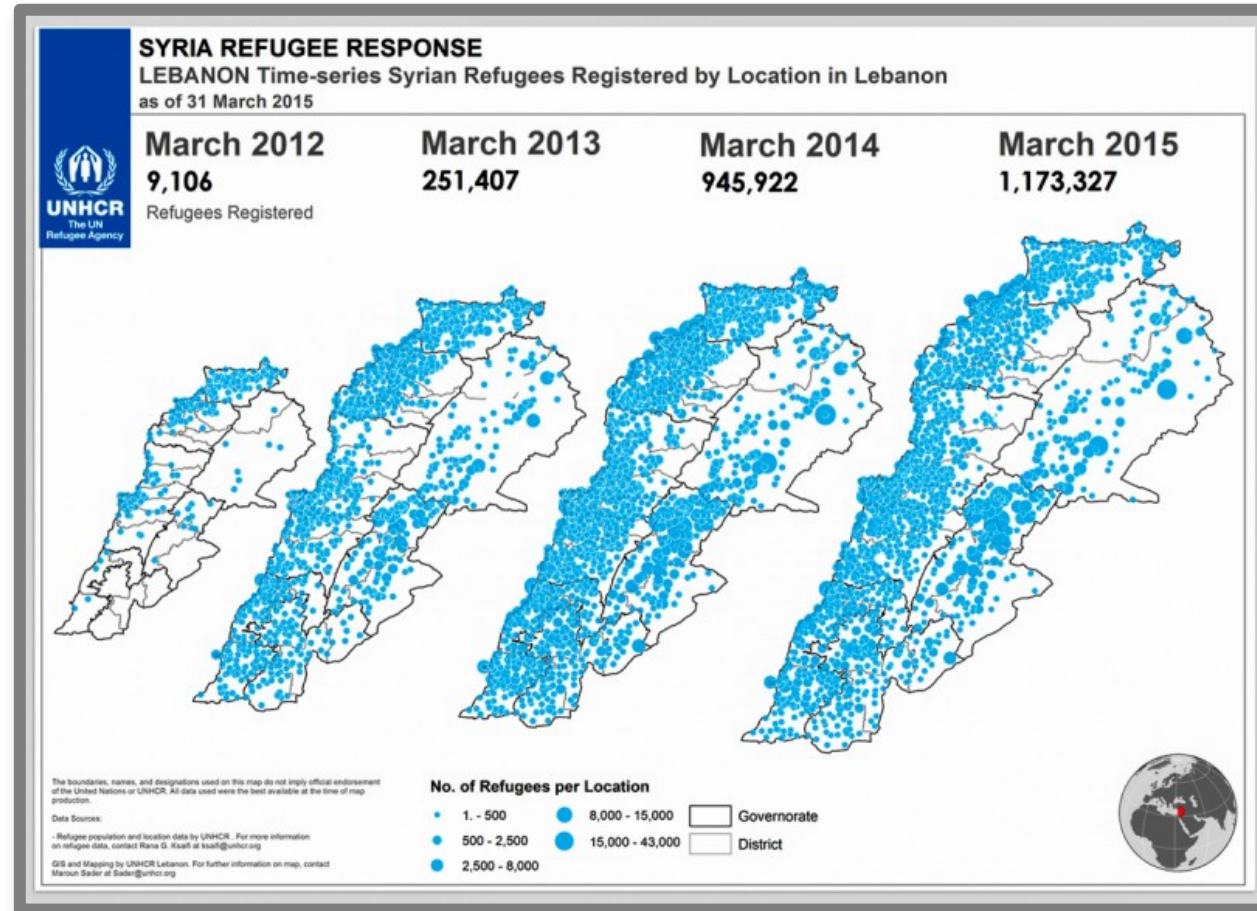

► Over 200,000 Syrian refugee children registered in the public schools



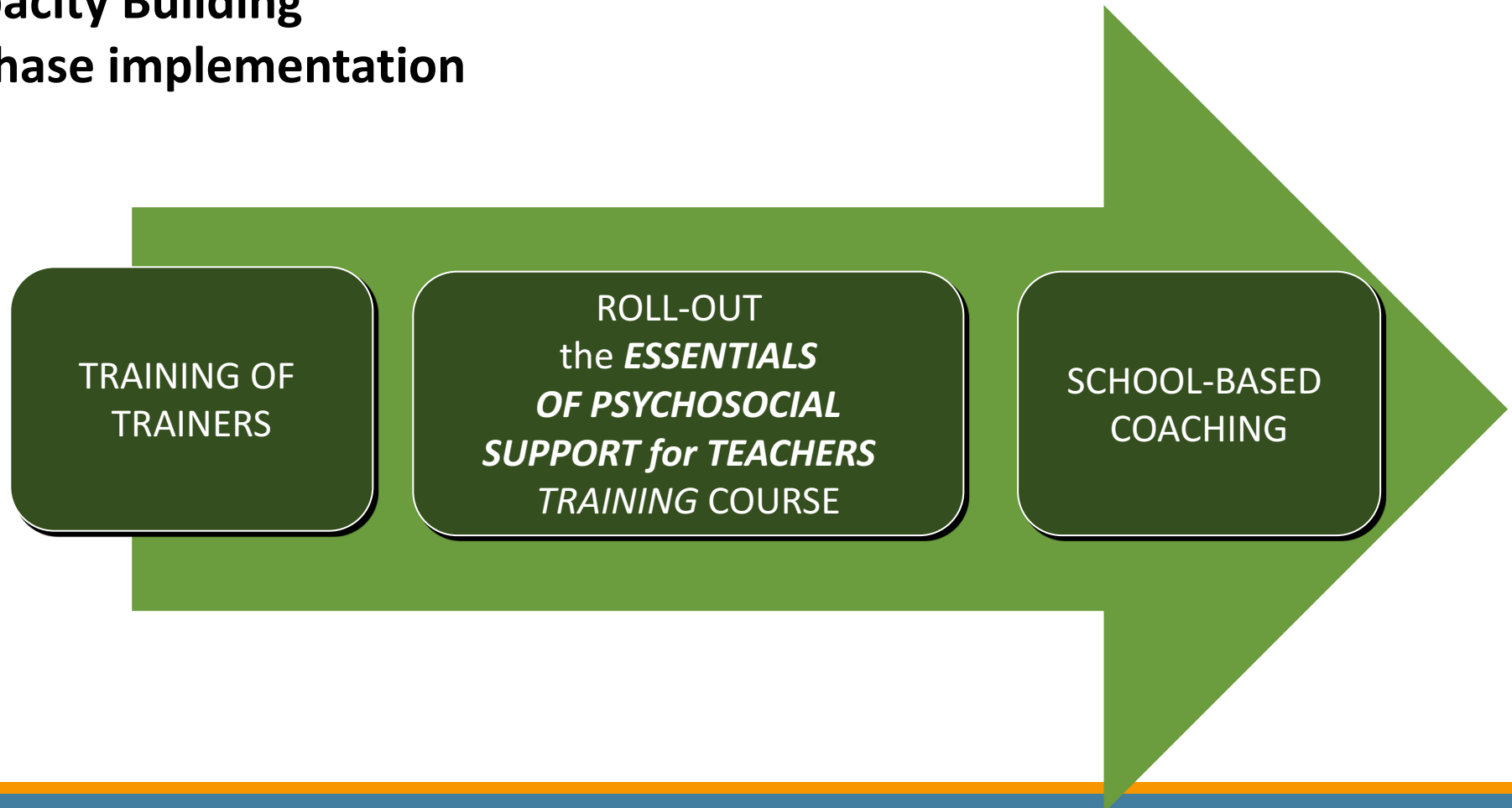
## *Psychosocial Support (PSS) Program*

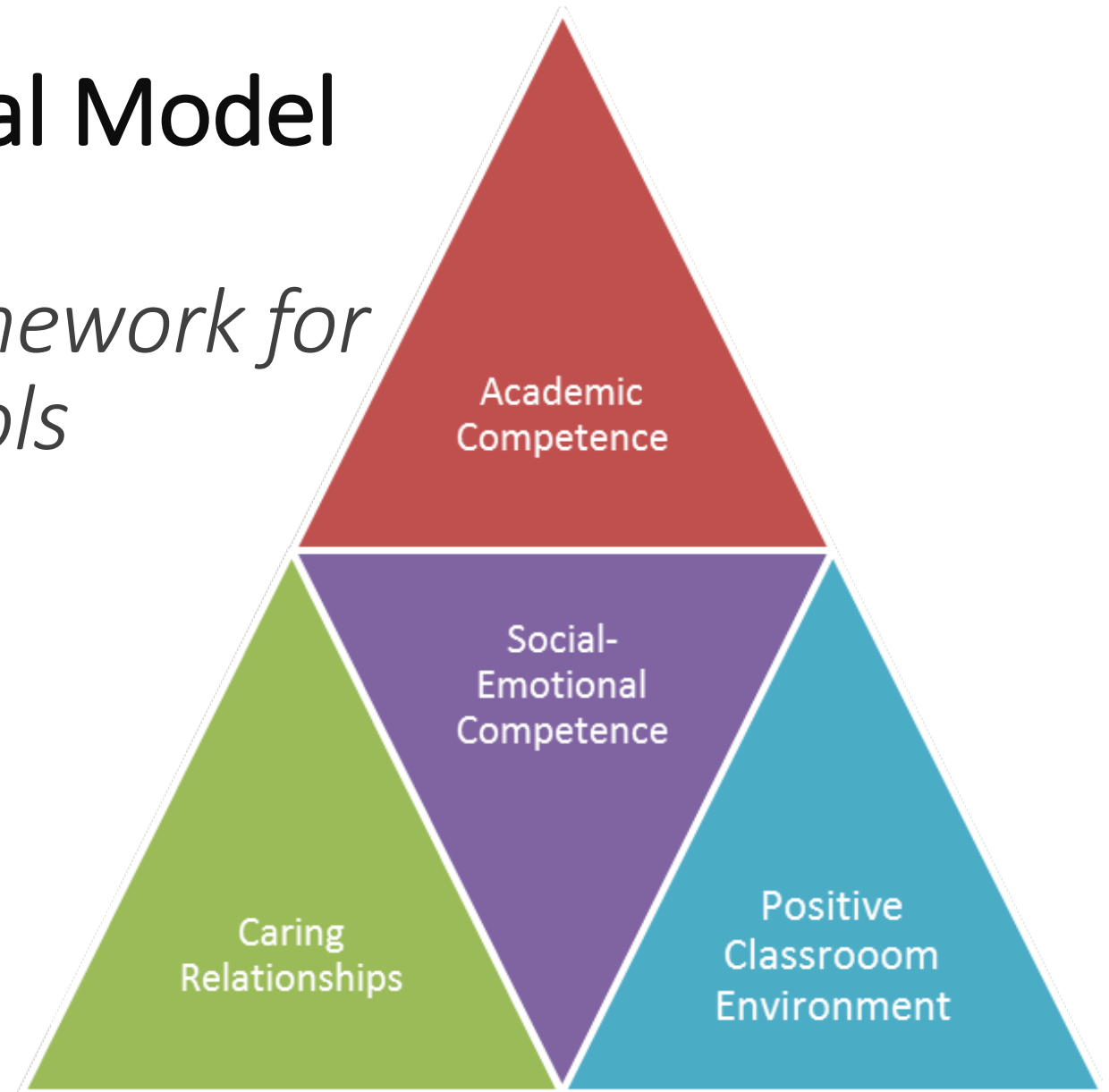

We are seeking to make a change in the schools. And this kind of change doesn't happen with just theorizing. These applied activities create a wonderful atmosphere in the schools.

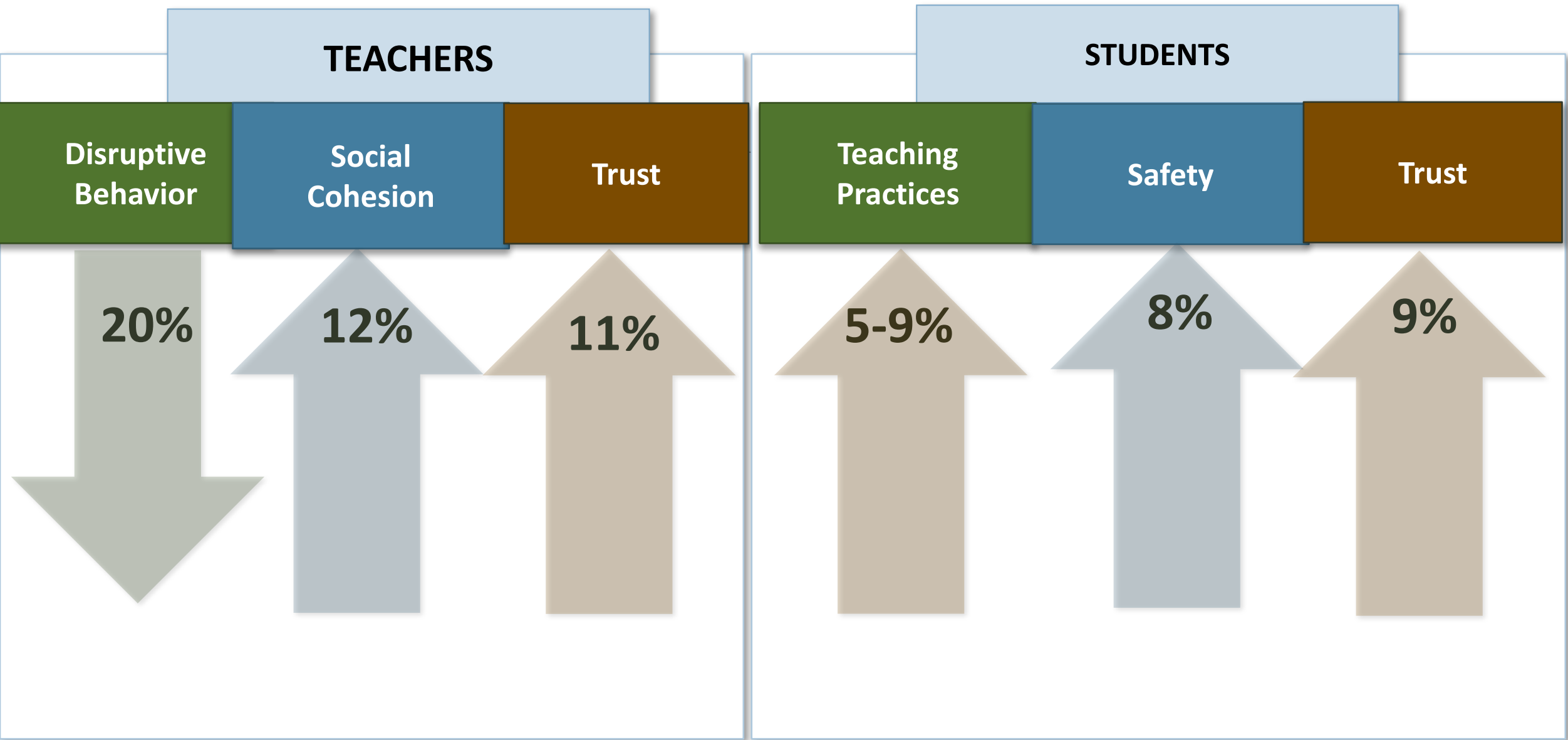


In the sessions there was a teacher who always dismissed students from her class and shouted at them. But on Day 2 when she learned about positive [discipline], which is very important. She changed her approach and the number of students dismissed from the classroom decreased significantly. She even worked with a student and helped him solve his problem.

Every teacher proudly and humbly says, "I made a change."

One of the teachers acknowledged that she used to be violent but wasn't aware of it. And now she is saying, "I made a change. And every time I raise my voice I start thinking about what was said during the training session."
