

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






# So... then what?

- Hungary: one of the least popular topics for ELL



# Pronunciation

awareness raising (Laura Patsko)

- one's own voice, others' voice, language in context, etc.
- difficulties due to mother tongue?
  - "sound hunt" (Laura Patsko)
  - practise stress and intonation in connected speech: "Now, why would they need an old forest like me anyomre?"

# Pronunciation

#### Give me your info

- detective decoding activity to practise minimal pairs
- digits 0-9 correspond to a word from a minimal pair
  e.g. "2 = thumb, 3 = some"
- take some data about rainforests, e.g. "32 million acres lost annually"
- students dictate the numbers
